ORIGINS

- Open daily with indoor seating only.
- No alcohol will be served in Origins.

IFTAR is from sunset until 9PM. An Arabic and international buffet will be served with traditional dishes to celebrate this special time

SUHOOR is from 9PM until 12:30 AM (last order for food) and 1AM for beverages from the à la carte menu, with Arabic and international options.

IN-ROOM DINING

Available 24/7.

SUHOOR

starts from 9PM until 3:30AM (last order for food) on the à la carte menu with Arabic and international options.

STAGE 2 COURTYARD

- Open from Iftar until 1AM (last order is 12:30AM).
- Shisha service is available during these times.

STAGE 2 INDOOR

Open from Iftar until 1AM (last order is 12:30AM).

Closed throughout Ramadan.

POOL BAR

Closed throughout Ramadan.

Please be advised that no refreshments or drinks will be served poolside or by the beach during fasting hours.
